

COLLECTION OF TAXES/RECOVERY (2023-24)

ET&NC Department has achieved another milestone by collecting more than 43642 Million of 43508 Million target.

This achievement, no doubt, is a result of supervision and guidance of Secretary ET&NCD, DG E&T Punjab and team efforts of all field officers/officials who worked day and night to achieve the assigned target of recovery by the Government of Punjab.

Rawalpindi division remained at top with 110% recovery, Region-B Lahore stood at 2nd with 106%, Sahiwal division stood at 3rd with 104%, Region-C Lahore stood at 4th with 104% and Gujranwala division stood at 5th position with 103%.



MOU SIGNING CEREMONY WITH BOP





A MoU was signed between BOP and ET&NCD on 30.07.2024 in the Administrative Department. Mr. Nofal Dawood , Chief Digital Officer, from BOP and Muhammad Masood Mukhtar, Secretary, ET&NCD signed the MoU. The main objective was to establish booths at each divisional headquarter for collection of government receipts over the counter and for those taxes which are yet not automated by ET&NCD as well as those taxes which are already automated and their payment be made through generating PSID. BOP will initially establish 06 booths in Lahore and 10 at divisional headquarter. This initiative will provide facilitation for the general public in timely payment of their taxes without any hassle.

E-PROCUREMENT TRAINING



E-procurement is introduced by Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) to streamline the procurement process by automating activities such as supplier registration, bidding, purchasing, and e-payments. It enhances transparency, reduces paperwork, and accelerates decision-making by providing a secure and efficient platform for managing the procurement process. E-procurement has been implemented in the ET&NC department from 01.07.2024, following the directions issued by the Chief Secretary of Punjab.

RETIREMENT CEREMONY

Mr. Allah Ditta, Naib Qasid, and Mr. Ghulam Qadir, Naib Qasid in the Administrative Department, have retired from government service upon reaching superannuation on 14.07.2024 and 30.06.2024 respectively. NCCC MEETING

A meeting of Narcotics Coordination Control Committee was held on 20.08.2024 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, ET&NC Department to discuss the agendas related to updated status of the Court directions, ADP scheme for rehabilitation centers, students health profiling and draft Punjab narcotics control policy. The Director General, Narcotics Control Punjab and representatives of all concerned departments participated in the meeting. After a detailed discussion, the chair emphasized the concerned departments to complete tasks assigned to them as per decisions made in the meeting and play a positive role in the efforts being made to curb the menace of drug abuse in the society.



DIRECTORS' CONFERENCE

The director Conference was held on 08.08.2024 under the chairmanship of Secretary, ET&NCD to review the collection of taxes in CFY 2024-25. It was apprised that recovery target for 2024-25 is fixed at Rs. 56.950 billion out of which 3.81 billion recovered in July 2024 which is 26% plus than last corresponding month. The chair mainly focused on collection of taxes, completion of implementation process for CVT shift of UIPT and distribution of number plates/smart cards to owners. DG, E&T was requested to constitute a working group including members of E&T, PRLA, Urban Unit etc to implement the CVT regime effectively. All other procedural and legal requirements

in this regard may be made well in time.

Further as regards delivery of plates/cards, all Directors, E&T were advised to resolve the petty issues of number plates/cards at their level, held meeting with vendors of number plates and distribute the plates to owners address which they receive from the Directorate General, E&T Punjab.
