## Recovery made during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter

The ET&NCD has made collection of taxes amounting to **Rs. 34.140 Billion** against target of **Rs. 45.497 Billion** showing a percentage of **75%** against target upto **March 2024**.

Upto Mar, 2024, the Directorate, **Region-B Lahore** remained top with **83%** followed by **Rawalpindi** at **79%** and **Sahiwal** **77%**.
