

SHIFTING OF PROPERTY TAX VALUATION SYSTEM FROM ANNUAL RENTAL VALUE TO CAPITAL VALUE (DC RATE)

ET&NC Department, has achieved a significant milestone by shifting the valuation system of properties from annual rental value to capital value (DC Rates). This paradigm shift has been made since promulgation of Punjab UIPT Act 1958. This change was made in order to broaden the tax base, for bringing transparency in tax assessment system, curtailing the discretionary powers of staff, minimizing unnecessary exemptions and bringing properties into tax net with ultimate objective of revenue generation. VISIT OF THE PROBATIONARY OFFICERS TO ET&NCD/ DIRECTOR GENERAL EXCISE & TAXATION OFFICE

A Syndicate of probationary officers from Civil Services Academy led by Syed Zulfiqar Hussain Advisor / Director Drug Advisory Training Hub (DATH) visited Director General Excise & Taxation Punjab on 28.11.2024 for briefing on establishment and functions of Counter Narcotics Force. Briefing was conducted by Secretary ET&NC and DG Counter Narcotic Force along with DG Excise and Taxation Punjab.

Secretary Excise Punjab reviewed the performance of Multan Division and emphasized on further improvement of tax collections of property tax, excise branch and motor branch, saying that the inspector whose recovery is less than the set half-yearly target, show cause notices should be issued to them and those who have more than 50% recovery should be encouraged. Secretary ET&NC Punjab reviewed the performance of all the ETOs individually and advised them to use all their capabilities to ensure achievement of tax targets.

Secretary ET&NC assured Director Excise Multan Iftikhar Ahmed about the bad condition of the excise building. Secretary ET&NC informed he will meet the Commissioner Multan to find a solution to this problem so that a better building can be provided to the Excise employees. Secretary ET&NC Punjab said that DC rate will be applicable on all units in the property tax net from January 1, from which the department will get additional revenue. He once again directed all ETOs to improve tax recovery. On this occasion Director Multan Division, Multan Iftikhar Ahmed along with District Officer Admin Khalid Hussain Kasuri, ETO Arif Shaikh, Abdul Majeed Qureshi, Chaudhry Ejaz Ahmed, Muhammad Aleem Akhtar, Syed Muhammad Raza Shah, Muhammad Shahbaz and Muhammad Younis Gondal were also present.

APPOINTMENT OF GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMISSIONER

Secretary, Excise & Taxation has been nominated as Grievances Redressal Commissioner by the Services and General Administration Department to providing a platform for public to have their concerns attended to before knocking the doors of court.
