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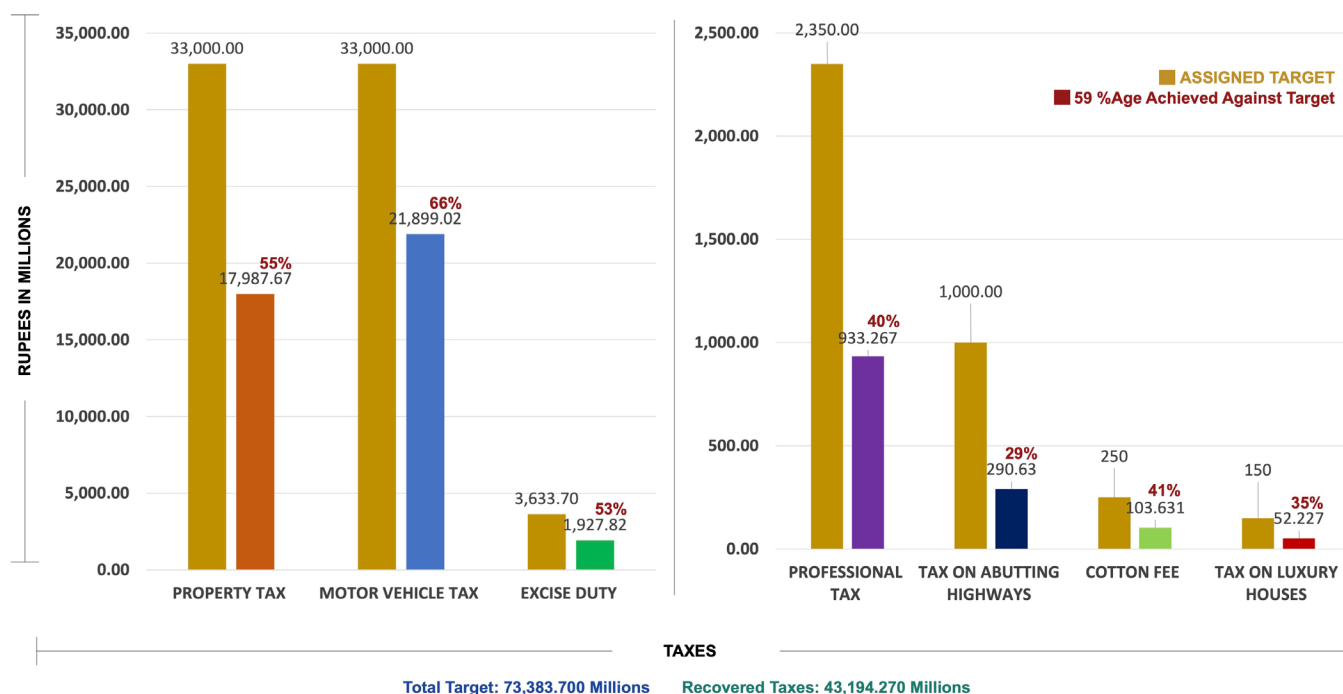

STATUS AT THE END OF 2ND QUARTER RECOVERY

By the end of 2nd Quarter in December 2025, the Excise & Taxation Department successfully collected **Rs. 43,194.270 Million** in revenue, achieving **59%** of the annual target set by the government. This performance reflects the department's continued efforts toward efficient tax collection and fiscal responsibility.

ESTABLISHING OF SPECIAL COURTS

Punjab Counter Narcotics Force was established in 2024 having professionally experienced and trained through ANF Academy. The force has established its Headquarter at Lahore and 09 Narcotics Control Stations at each divisional headquarter is in the process of establishing their network at each district in the Punjab. For functioning of the Punjab CNF, a Provincial Law titled, "The Punjab Control of Narcotics Substances Act, 2025" was enacted by the Provincial Assembly Punjab on 5th August, 2025. For trial of CNF cases, section 38 of the Act empowers that the government may establish special courts in consultation with the Chief Justices of Lahore High Court. Hence, after completion of the due legal process the government vide notification dated 13.11.2025

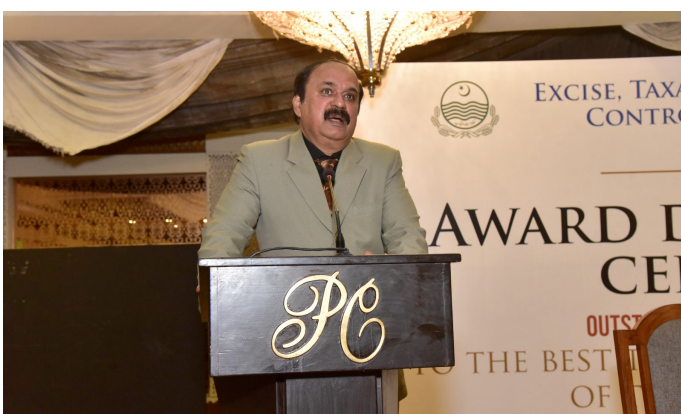


has notified the special courts in the Punjab whereby all the session judges, additional session judges and judicial magistrate of first class are empowered to try all offences under Punjab CNS Act, 2025.

PUNJAB ET&NCD ROLLOUT WORKSHOPS ON IMPLEMENTATION & TRANSITION TO CAPITAL VALUATION

GIZ is implementing the Participatory Local Governance (PLG) Programme, co-funded by the European Union and implemented in cooperation with the Pakistan Ministry of Finance, Revenue and Economic Affairs and subnational stakeholders. One of the outputs of this programme aims to improve the human resource capacity and local governments for local revenue generation and digital financial management. Shifting of ARV taxation system to Capital based Taxation in the Punjab was not

only a technical change but it also have impact on legal, procedural, administrative etc process. Hence, it was necessary to engage senior level management of the ET&NCD for effective implementation of new transition through arranging a workshop in October 2025 at Murree to align strategy with consistency and confidence. The objective of this assignment was to design and deliver a two-day Senior Management Planning Workshop as part of PJ ETNCD's transition from an Annual Rental Value (ARV) to a Capital

Valuation (CV)-based property tax system. The objectives includes to align ETNCD leadership on the strategic direction and key components of the CV-based UIPT transition, and acknowledge the nature and scale of the transition challenge, identify outstanding tasks, institutional gaps, and stakeholder coordination requirements, define departmental roles, responsibilities, and timelines and address operational challenges in assessment, administration, billing, collection, and enforcement for province-wide rollout and build senior officers' capacity in change management, inter-agency coordination, strategic implementation planning, legal preparedness, stakeholder communication, and managing institutional stress during reform.
